(a) Deny Former Husband's Motion Objecting to Court Orders Granting Former Wife's Request for Attorney's Fees,



ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. To the extent that Petitioner's Motion and Memorandum of Law to Terminate Alimony seeks a non evidentiary legal determination that the alimony provisions contained in Florida Statutes Chapter 61 are unconstitutional, or otherwise seeks a declaratory judgment that Florida Statutes Chapter 61 is violative of either the Florida or Federal Constitution, or otherwise seeks an injunction prohibiting enforcement of this Court's prior award of alimony to Former Wife, the motion is denied with prejudice. Former Husband is specifically enjoined from refileing any pleading seeking the relief sought by him in the subject Motion

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on August 29, 2005 on Former Husband's Motion to Deny Former Wife's Amended Motion for Contempt, Notice of Intent to Use Summaries and Compilations, Motion to Dismiss Supplemental Petition for Modification, Notice of Production from Non Party, Motion to Strike Contempt Defenses, Motion to Compel Production, Interrogatories and Financial Affidavit and in Addition Former Husband's Motion for Change of Venue (D.E.157). The Court, having considered the motion, legal argument and being otherwise fully advised in the premises,

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. To the extent that Former Husband seeks an Order Denying Former Wife's

Amended Motion for Contempt, same is denied as insufficient legal grounds have been asserted in support of the motion.

2. To the extent that Former Husband's motion seeks to deny Former Wife's Notice of Intent to Use Summaries and Compilations, same is denied. Former Husband's argument that the Former Wife's summaries do not agree with the Clerks's records is an insufficient basis to strike Former Wife's properly filed Notice of Intent to Use Summaries and Compilations.

3. To the extent that Former Husband seeks to compel production, same is moot.

4. To the extent that Former Husband seeks a change in venue, same is denied.

5. To the extent that Former Husband's motion addresses Former Wife's previously filed Motion to Dismiss, same is addressed in a separate order entered by this Court of even date.
